TO: All Signatory Masonry Contractors

RE: Mason Contractors' Association – 2011 Allocation

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

There is a previously negotiated \$0.55 per hour increase effective June 1, 2011, with \$0.60 per hour allocated to Pension. The additional \$0.05 per hour is to be deducted from the wage rate. Please see the wages and fringe benefit changes listed below.

During the May, 2010 District Council Dues Convention, a motion was passed to adjust the dues check-off deduction to 3.25% of the average of the four area Master Labor Agreement General Laborer wage rates. Effective June 1, 2011 the dues check-off amount deducted from net wages for all areas covered by this District Council is **\$0.85** per hour.

The changes in wages and fringe benefits for 2011 are listed below.:
